Removal of the Privileging Requirement

Published FEBRUARY 2020

The privileging requirement to assign Diagnostic Imaging Procedure (DIP) levels will be discontinued on **February 28, 2019** for all Advanced Imaging and Cardiology services.

Disclaimer: 'privileging' and 'credentialing' are different processes. The change described here only applies to privileging to perform imaging procedures at the various DIP levels. Credentialing is a process that applies to all providers within Highmark's network. It is part of how a provider is contracted with Highmark. All providers still need to be credentialed and contracted within the Highmark network. Providers who are not credentialed will be treated as non-contracted and out of network.

Other Changes

- The **DIP Levels** document has been removed as DIP Levels are no longer necessary.
