Highmark is pleased to announce you can now earn American Medical Association (AMA) Physician Recognition Award (PRA) Category 1 Continuing Medical Education (CME) credits for the Transitions of Care module in Population Health University.

RECEIVING CME CREDIT

All CME credits are obtained through the Allegheny Health Network (AHN) CME platform. To earn CME credits, you must register for an account [here](#). Once an account is created you will not need to re-register in the future for Highmark/AHN CME offerings.

You will be eligible to receive partial CME credit for the individual components of the module that you complete, or full credit for completing the entire module. **You are only able to apply for CMEs for the Transition of Care Module one time.** Ensure you complete all components you want credit for prior to submitting CME credit.
