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<b>GeoBlue</b>	The GeoBlue group health plan covers business travelers, expatriates, and their families. GeoBlue enables participating Blue Plans to provide their clients traveling the world with the care they need when and where they need it from trusted doctors and hospitals. GeoBlue is the trade name for Worldwide Insurance Services, Inc. (WIS), an independent licensee of the Blue Cross and Blue Shield Association. GeoBlue products are offered in select markets with participating Blue Cross and Blue Shield companies.
<b>Group Health Plan</b>	A health plan offered by an employer that provides health coverage to employees and their dependents.
<b>Group Practice</b>	Two or more providers practicing as a group may establish an assignment account to have the group recognized as a single entity for purposes of billing and payment. Examples of a typical group practice arrangement are: two or more providers practice as a partnership; a group of providers form a professional corporation and the corporation becomes the employer of the providers; a provider employs one or more other providers as associates in his or her practice.
<b>Guaranteed Issue</b>	Under guaranteed issue, a health insurer must provide coverage to an applicant regardless of prior medical history.
