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Incorporated solo practitioner	An incorporated solo practitioner is one who desires to have the corporation recognized as the entity or to use a tax identification number to receive payment from Highmark.
Indemnity	Traditional indemnity plans are sometimes referred to as fee-for-service plans in that they pay a set amount for each health care service performed. It gives members the widest choice of physicians and services through participating providers. Generally, these plans are subject to a deductible and coinsurance.
Initial Preventive Personal Examination (IPPE)	The Initial Preventive Personal Examination (IPPE), also known as the "Welcome to Medicare Visit," is provided to new beneficiaries within 12 months of enrolling in Medicare.
Inpatient	Inpatient services are those provided to a patient who is admitted as an inpatient of a facility such as a hospital or skilled nursing facility.
Intensive Outpatient Program	<p>Intensive outpatient programs provide planned and structured services at least two hours per day or six hours per week to address a mental-health or substance-abuse disorder and include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Group, individual, family or multi-family group psychotherapy • Multiple or extended treatment/rehabilitation/counseling visits • Professional supervision and support • Crisis intervention, psychiatric/psychosocial rehabilitation or day treatment models • Psycho-educational services • Adjunctive services, such as medical monitoring <p>Note: These services are provided by an intensive outpatient program-contracted facility or agency.</p>
InterQual[®] Level of Care	InterQual [®] Level of Care is a nationally recognized criteria set used by Highmark's Clinical Services staff in reviewing the medical necessity and appropriateness of services.
