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<b>Teledermatology</b>	Teledermatology is the use of secure telecommunications technology to deliver dermatologic services and clinical information remotely. It uses technology that allows the patient to send digital images and personal information to the consulting dermatologist. The dermatologist views the images and reviews the information provided by the patient to determine if the patient can be treated virtually. Patients for whom the diagnosis remains unclear or who have potentially serious conditions can be scheduled for an in-person office visit.
<b>Telemedicine</b>	Telemedicine is defined as the exchange of medical information between sites via electronic communication for transmitting clinical information for diagnostic, monitoring, and therapeutic purposes. The term “telehealth” is often used in conjunction with telemedicine and is intended to include a broader range of services using telecommunication technologies, including videoconferencing.
<b>Timely Filing</b>	Timely filing is a Highmark requirement whereby a claim must be filed within a certain time period after the last date of service relating to such claim or the payment/denial of the primary payer. If a claim is not received within the timely filing time frame, it will be denied by Highmark.
<b>Trading Partner</b>	A trading partner is an entity that conducts business electronically with Highmark. Providers, clearinghouse/billing services, and software vendors are the most common types of trading partners who enter into agreements with Highmark.
<b>Traditional Indemnity Plans</b>	Traditional indemnity plans are sometimes referred to as “fee-for-service” plans in that they pay a set amount per health care service performed. It gives members the widest choice of physicians and services through participating providers. Generally, these plans are subject to a deductible and coinsurance.
<b>Transition of Care</b>	The movement of patients between health care locations, providers, or different levels of care within the same location as their conditions and care needs change.
