**INFORMED CONSENT**

Informed consent is a legal doctrine that requires physicians to obtain consent for proposed treatment, surgery, or diagnostic studies.

The following methods will be used for securing consent:

- A. The patient will sign his/her full name on the consent form. If the patient is under 18 years of age, the parent or legal guardian must sign the consent form. The nurse or medical assistant will sign his/her full name as the witness.
- B. All common complications and risks of the procedure will be documented on the consent form.
- C. The physician will review any complications and risks with the patient prior to the procedure.
- D. The patient will be advised to notify the office if there are any adverse reactions and this will be documented in the chart along with the consent form.
