Dear [Parent/Guardian]:

As your child's Primary Care Physician, I'd like to remind you that all children should have the recommended well-child visits and immunizations to help make sure children stay healthy. Over the past two years, COVID-19 has caused interruptions in children's and teen's check-ups and vaccinations. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) recommend children/teens catch up on routine childhood and adolescent immunizations following disruptions from COVID-19 public health emergency.

Well-child visits are important for many reasons, including:

- Tracking growth and development milestones
- Discussing any concerns about your child's health
- Getting scheduled immunizations to prevent illnesses like measles, whooping cough (pertussis), meningitis, and other [serious diseases](#)

Making sure that your child sees their doctor for well-child and well-adolescent visits and recommended vaccines is one of the best things you can do to protect your child/teen and community from serious diseases that are easily spread.
