CDC GUIDANCE ON 2019 NOVEL CORONAVIRUS INFECTION AVAILABLE

Cases of 2019 Novel Coronavirus infection began recently in Wuhan, China. On January 21, 2020, the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) <u>confirmed a travel-related case in the United States</u>, and additional cases are being identified in a growing number of countries in Asia.

REVIEW THE LATEST CDC GUIDANCE

Although the CDC considers this infection a concern, the risk to the US public is considered low at this time.

The CDC is advising health care providers to be alert for patients with respiratory symptoms and a history of recent travel to Asia, particularly Wuhan, China. Symptoms associated with this infection include fever, cough, and trouble breathing.
