Credentialing Crosswalk for Organizational Providers

Facility/Ancillary	 Facility and Ancillary providers, also referred to as Organizational Providers, are "brick and mortar" providers that provide services. Organizational Providers have credentials like Professional Providers but are in the name of the organization. Medical providers rendering facility-based services and/or billing for services on UB-04 claim forms, which are not directly billed by a professional provider. Ancillary Providers are freestanding and facility- based providers billing on a 1500 claim form. Examples: DME Supplier, Home Health Agency, Acute Care Facility, Skilled Nursing Facility.
