As the federal government announced recently, an extension of the ICD-10 implementation deadline was passed by the U.S. House of Representatives and U.S. Senate and was signed by the president. Consequently, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) is now revising its ICD-10 implementation timeline, and the health care community is awaiting its guidance.
