## Quality Blue Physician P4V

### Program Measures Available Online

In preparation for the April 1, 2014 release of the newly evolved Quality Blue Physician Pay for Value (P4V) program, participants will have online access to coding details for each quality measure. Masthead specifications are available for all 26 scored and 27 profiled measures. Coming soon, a program manual will be available to provide further details on the Quality Blue Physician P4V program. It will replace Chapter 7 of the HBSOM.
