2016 West Virginia Family Health Primary Care Incentive Program

Clinical Quality Feedback Now Open for WVFH

We are pleased to announce the Clinical Quality Feedback (CQF) functionality is now open in Highmark's Provider Portal for the West Virginia Family Health Primary Care Incentive Program. The CQF function allows providers to submit clinical data documented in the patient's medical record to supplement what does not appear in Gateway claims data.

To educate the use of the CQF functionality, a Clinical Quality Feedback Supplemental Guide was prepared and available in the West Virginia Family Health site, which lists measures available for submission and the required documentation. The detailed table of contents begins with an introduction to the tool, navigating tips by making a submission, the timeline for submissions and an appendix specifically for nine measures.
